The course presents methods of voice-over performance, including sight-reading, pacing, diction, enunciation, and breathing, as well as script analysis and interpretation. Finding space in your home or apartment and buying the right microphone, computer, and recording software can be a confusing and expensive undertaking. This course explains and simplifies the process of planning and outfitting an affordable home-based voice-over recording studio that will allow you to audition for voice-over work from home and create your own voice-over production.
